



SEVA BHARATHI (R.) MANGALURU

In the year 1991, a group of service minded home makers and doctors formed "Seva Bharathi". During the past 3 decades, the activities of the Trust have expanded manifold both in scope and scale. Today, it is widely recognized as a registered organization providing special services to the "Divyang".

Seva Bharathi is in the service of 'special children' with multiple disabilities, impaired vision, autism and the victims of endosulfan. The activities include classroom education, skill development, capacity building, talent identification / development, assistance to thalassemia patients, medical and health care, holding blood donation camps, day care center, advisory services to senior citizens and such other social, humanitarian causes.

Trust is registered under Section 12A of the Income Tax Act, 1961, as a non-profit charitable organization and contributions to the Trust are eligible for exemption under Sec 80 G of Income Tax Act. Trust is eligible to receive donations under FCRA (Foreign Contributions Regulation Act 2010). Trust is also registered with Registrar of Companies, Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Govt. of India, for undertaking CSR Activities and **Registration No. is CSR00013116**.

“Seva Bharathi” a registered charitable Trust is in the service of the most vulnerable and disadvantageously placed sections of the society for the past 30 years.

The Trust, through its dedicated teachers, trainers, doctors, staff, counsellors, resource persons, and volunteers are rendering services to the children facing challenges of physical, mental disabilities, impaired vision, endosulfan victims, besides supporting the senior citizens to manage their age-related constraints.

The day care services comprise the vital aspects like health care, physiotherapy, education, self-reliance, vocational skill development, capacity and confidence building.

During all these three decades of selfless, charitable services of the Trust, the scope and scale of the activities is ever expanding. The support, contribution, involvement, guidance, love, kindness of persons like you is the foundation on which our activities are built upon.

New challenges, requirements, plans and projects:

As the activities expand, the challenges and requirements too rise. With passing years, the parents, guardians find it difficult to spare energy and time on their “special children”. The painful question of “What would be the future of these children after the life time of their parents?” is confronting many already.

The Trust has taken proactive view of these challenges and ventured into an ambitious, noble project of “Residential accommodation” for the special children. In Naringana village of Bantwal Taluk of the Dakshina Kannada District, Construction of “Infosys Foundation-Seva Bharathi School for Divyang” building complex is underway in six acres of land (Madhava Vana), at an estimated cost of ₹14 crore. This complex generously funded by Infosys Foundation will have class rooms, vocational training halls, physiotherapy hall, medical treatment facilities, library, hostel facility and function hall for these children.



Our services include care for senior citizens in the name of Ananth Soukhyia. We intend to further increase our service activities by providing day care centre, short stay home (Dementia) & such other facilities for senior citizens and also for divyang as an added independent facility in Madhava Vana campus at the estimated cost of ₹5 crores.

The proposed construction would involve three floors besides ground floor. In all there would be 15 rooms (400 SFT each) and 16 residential apartments (700 SFT each) in the building.

Since the upscaling project cost outlay is substantial and Trust functions solely on charitable basis, the funding of the project is envisaged out of generous contributions from sponsors, donors as proposed here below:

A. Sponsoring construction of one floor: ₹1 crore.

B. Sponsoring one apartment: ₹15 lacs.

C. Sponsoring one room: ₹12 lacs.

Any contributing amount from the donors would be gratefully acknowledged. Names of donors of ₹1 lac and above would be engraved in display.

About “Madhava Vana”

The “Madhava Vana” land measuring 6 acres is located amidst lush green environs at a distance of about 22 KMs from Mangaluru in Montepadavu, Naringana village of Bantwal Taluk. Dr. Madhava Kamath a philanthropist, has donated this land in furtherance of the service activities.

Infosys Foundation, Bengaluru are generously funding the ongoing construction of “Infosys Foundation – Seva Bharathi School for Divyang” under the CSR activities of parent organization Infosys Ltd.

“Madhava Vana” is also being developed as a repository of rare, precious, extinction threatened tropical trees and plants.
